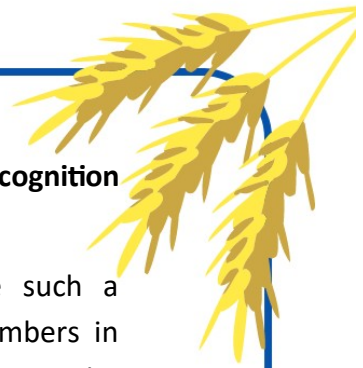

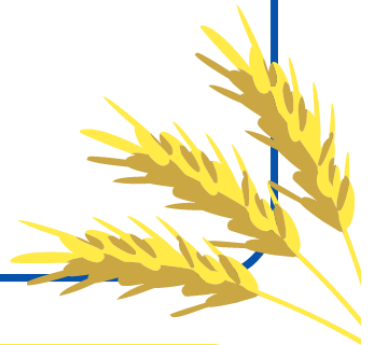

The new friends couldn't believe what they found.

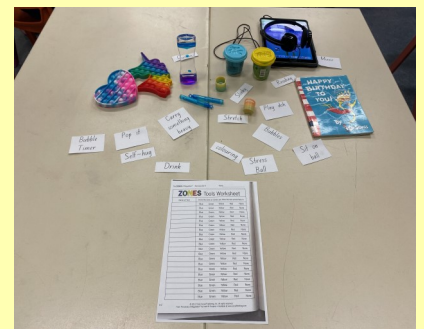

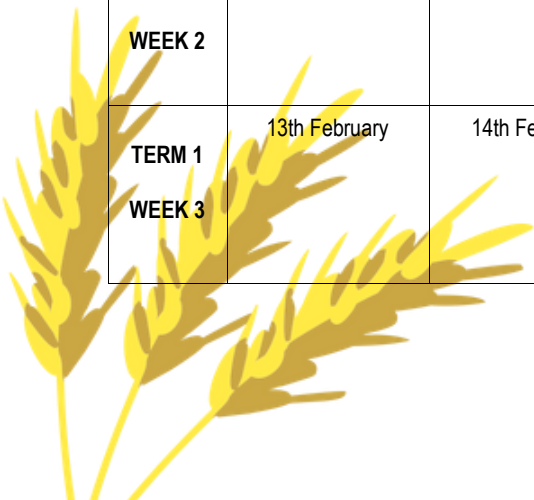

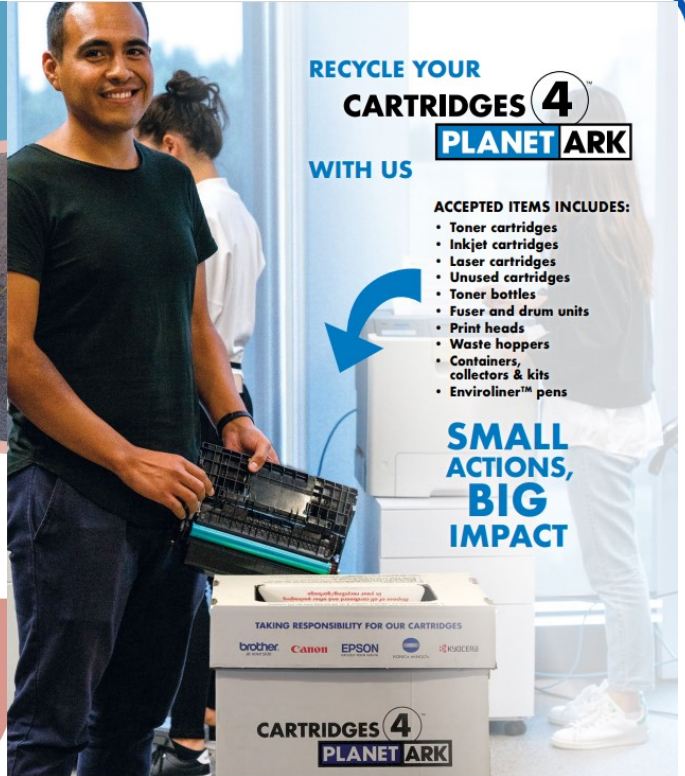

The Binnu Tennis Club has now taken on the responsibility for the running of the Binnu Hall. As such, we are asking families in the community that benefit from having the hall facilities available to them, to share in this by paying a levy so that this doesn't just fall to membership paying tennis players.

Last year this levy helped pay for half the total cost of cleaning. You can understand how much it helps and your continued support of hall and tennis functions and recent catering jobs helps us pay the rest.

At the last meeting it was decided that **\$50 per family per year** was a fair amount and **no hall or equipment hire would be charged for those that paid this**. This is unchanged from last year.

Adult tennis membership (\$75)

Hall levy (\$50 per family)

Primary school aged children (\$15)

Children 13-17yrs (\$20)

Social membership (\$30)

Payment by EFT is preferred. You get 3 playing dates reprieve then we start charging a light fee of \$10 a week per person for tennis players (visitor's fee).
